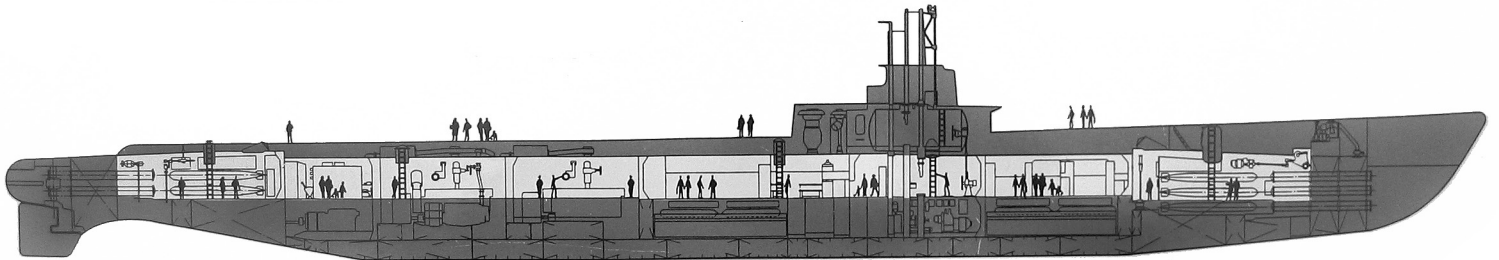

### Helpful Vocabulary

Port	Left side of the submarine (when facing the bow)
Starboard	Right side of the submarine (when facing the bow)
Knot	Short for Nautical Mile. This is how ships measure speed and distance on the ocean
Generator	Where power (electricity) is created and stored
Galley	The area of the submarine where the crew would eat their meals
After	The <b>Back</b> end of the submarine (also called the 'AFT' or 'Stern')
Forward	The <b>Front</b> end of the submarine (also called the 'FWD' or 'Bow')
